



The rock cycle changes rock. It changes rock from one type to another. A rock is a solid mixture of minerals. There are three types of rocks. There are different ways that rocks can be changed.

Weathering changes rocks. Weathering wears away rock. This happens over time. Wind breaks down rocks. Toe breaks down rocks. Rain breaks down rocks. Rocks are broken into tiny pieces.
